

Environmental Education Internship



The Baird Creek Preservation Foundation seeks one paid seasonal intern (approximately 30-35 hours per week for 10-12 weeks), starting mid-May 2026 through early August, to assist education staff in running summer camps and other programs in the Baird Creek Greenway. Set camp hours will be Monday-Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., June-early August, with a lunch break. You will also help with school field trips scheduled for May, as well as other programs on Fridays and evenings during the week June-August. Please note that this is a paid summer hire/internship. Salary is \$14.00 per hour.

Specific Education Intern (Program Leader) Tasks can include:

- Work together to prepare, lead, and coordinate daily camp activities, which may include arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, enrichment activities, service-learning opportunities, etc.
- Follow lesson plans.
- Guide appropriate camper behavior and hands-on outdoor education
- Ensure the safety of all participants
- Relationship-building skills with school-aged children (K-6th grade) and their families
- Working collaboratively with the Education Director
- Following directives from the Education Director
- Cleanup of facility at end of day

Successful candidates will be outgoing, adaptable, creative, have a willingness to be outdoors, and have reliable transportation. Must be able to hike 2+ miles per day through uneven terrain.
